Linking Entity shall not link to individual graphics or tables within the COUNTY's Web site, subpage or content of the COUNTY's Web site, especially in an effort to place the downloading burden on the COUNTY's servers. Such an action will be treated by the COUNTY as exceeding the permission granted by this Agreement, as well as misuse of the COUNTY's Web site, subpage or content, and the associated computer system.

Extension of Term of the Permission

By mutual written consent of Linking Entity and the COUNTY, the term of the permission granted in this Agreement may be extended.

Termination or Revocation of Agreement

At any time, Linking Entity may terminate or revoke this Agreement, with or without cause. At any time, COUNTY may terminate or revoke this agreement, with or without cause. Any termination or revocation of this Agreement shall take effect as follows:

- 1. On the 3rd day after notice of the termination or revocation of this Agreement has been sent by email to the contact person; or
- 2. On the 7th day after notice of the termination or revocation of this Agreement has been sent by mail to the contact person: or
- 3. As may be otherwise agreed in writing by the Linking Entity and the COUNTY.

Amendments

This Agreement may be amended by mutual written consent of Linking Entity and the COUNTY.
